Our new name and corporate design allow us to convey a clearer and more visible impression of our renowned expertise as a leading automation provider in the fields of microassembly technology, high-speed assembly, plastic overmoulding technology and optical testing systems. MA micro automation will therefore be appearing on the market in three business areas targeting particular groups: **ma automotive, ma meditec and ma optronic**.

- **ma automotive** develops and produces custom systems that automate the production of driving assistance systems, precision plug-in connectors and sensors in the automotive supply industry.
- **ma meditec** supplies the medical equipment industry with assembly systems for medical devices (such as contact lenses, stents, inhalers, insulin pens and auto-injectors) and also offers services relating to compliance with quality guidelines and validation in medicine and pharmaceuticals production ('GMP documentation').
- **ma optronic** develops, programs and produces testing systems for industrial image editing such as those used for camera and optical systems and for automatic inspection facilities and process monitoring.

Of course, our new market image will not affect any our services or products at all, nor change the people whom you deal with inside the company. Giving up the name 'Rohwedder', to which considerable tradition is attached, is a further step in our company's integration into the M.A.X. Automation Group. As you know, all of the shares in MA micro automation GmbH have been owned by the stock exchange listed company M.A.X. Automation AG in Düsseldorf since November 2013. Being incorporated into this successful automation group with its turnover of well above €300 million opens up technological and operative synergies to our company that will benefit our customers.
